#### Safety Measures

To ensure proper use of this product, please take the time to read this instruction manual carefully before use. Please observe all the instructions about safe operation and please keep this instruction manual in a safe place for future

Protection of power supply wire: Do not place the cable in the path of foot traffic. Do not place heavy furniture on the cable. Never pull the cable to unplug the unit from the socket, always disconnect the unit from the main power supply

by pulling the plug out of the socket.

2. Ventilation: In order to prevent this unit from overheating, place it in a well-ventilated area on a stable surface. Never place it on a bed, sofa or

astable surface. Never jude it on a pet, sold a carpet where the ventilation will be restricted.

3. Dismantling: In order to avoid the risk of electric shock, do not dismantle the unit. Should your unit be faulty or broken please refer servicing to an authorized service center.

4. Strange Odor: Should the speaker emit any

strange odor, immediately unplug it from the wall socket. Do not use the unit again until you have had it repaired or contacted the manufacturer. 5. Do not expose this unit to liquid of any kind.







# Power On / Power Off

- 1. Power on: Press and hold [ U ] button for 3

## Bluetooth Mode

- 1. Turn on the speaker, the speaker will have a voice prompt "Ready to Pair".
- 2. Turn on your device and activate the Bluetooth
- Firefly" and click to pair, the speaker will pair automatically and the speaker will have a voice prompt "Paired Successfully".

4. Press [ 🔰 ] button to play music or control

settings from your device.

5. Hands-free: Press the [ ] button to answer the call; During a call, press the [ ] button to hang up the call.







#### Other Connections

- TF Card: Insert the TF card, the speaker will have a voice prompt "TF Card" and automatically play the music on the TF Card.
   U disk: Insert the U disk, the speaker will have a voice prompt "U disk" and automatically play
- the music on the U Disk.
- 3. Aux in: Use 3.5mm audio cable to connect speaker and other playback devices. The speaker will have a voice prompt "Line in".

4. FM mode: Press [ MODE ] button, switch to FM mode. The speaker will have a voice prompt 'FM
Tuner'. Click [ | ] button to automatically search
FM channels (auxiliary antenna can be plugged into the charging port)

# Power Bank Function

This speaker can charge a mobile phone, plug the USB port of the charging cable into the USB port of the speaker, and connect the other end to the phone to charge the phone.
