


# OUTBACK WATERPROOF BLUETOOTH SPEAKER

#### SAFETY MEASURES

To ensure proper use of this product, please take the time to read this instruction manual carefully before use. Please observe all the instructions about safe operation and please keep this instruction manual in a safe place for future reference.

1. Protection of power supply wire: Do not place the cable in the path of foot traffic. Do not place heavy furniture on the cable. Never pull the cable to unplug the unit from the socket, always disconnect the unit from the main power supply by pulling the plug out of


2. Ventilation: In order to prevent this unit from overheating, place it in a well-ventilated area on a stable surface. Never place it on a bed, sofa or carpet where the ventilation will be restricted.

3. Dismantling: In order to avoid the risk of electric shock, do not dismantle the unit. Should your unit be faulty or broken please refer servicing to an

4. Strange Odor: Should the speaker emit any strange odor, immediately unplug it from the wall socket. Do not use the unit again until you have had it repaired or contacted the manufacturer

5. Do not expose this unit to liquid of any kind.






#### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

#### CONTROL PANEL



Press and hold to turn power on/off; Doubleto turn on LED Lights; For calls, click to answer or end.

2. M Mode: press to switch setting for Bluetooth / MP3 / FM

Play / Pause; Press and hold to enter TWS Dual Connection mode; In FM Mode, click three times to automatically scan FM channels (auxiliary antenna can be connected to the charging port).

4. Press and hold to increase volume / click to go to the next song.


5. Press and hold to decrease the volume / click to go to the previous song.

#### CHARGE THE SPEAKER

Please charge the speaker for at least 3 hours before using it for the first time. Insert the charging cable into the Micro USB charging port, connect the USB plug into 5V/1A USB power Charger.



#### POWER ON / POWER OFF

1. Power on: Press and hold [🔁] button for 3 seconds, the speaker will be turned on, and a voice prompt of "Power on" will be issued.

2. Power off: Press and hold [ ] button for 2 seconds, the speaker will be turned off, and a voice prompt of "Power off" will be issued.

#### BLUETOOTH MODE


1. Turn on the speaker, the speaker will have a voice prompt "Ready to Pair"

2. Turn on your device and activate the Bluetooth

3. Search for Bluetooth pairing name "MyBat Pro Outback" and click to pair, the speaker will pair automatically and the speaker will have a voice prompt "Paired Successfully"

4. Press [  $\blacksquare$  ] button to play music or control the music settings from your phone.

5. Hands-free: Press the [ 💆 ] button to answer the call; During a call, press the [ 💆 ] button to hang up









## OTHER CONNECTIONS

1. TF Card: Insert the TF card, the speaker will have a voice prompt "TF Card" and automatically play the

2. U disk: Insert the U disk, the speaker will have a voice prompt "U disk" and automatically play the music on the U disk.

3. Aux in: Use 3.5mm audio cable to connect speaker and other playback devices. The speaker will have a voice prompt "Line in".

4. FM mode: Press [ M ] button, switch to FM mode. The speaker will have a voice prompt "FM Tuner". Three clicks [M] button to automatically search FM channels (plug in the charging line can be used as auxiliary antenna)

#### TWS MODE


1. Take two Outback speakers, turn them both on and

2. While both speakers are in Pairing mode, press the [ ] button to enter TWS Dual Connection Mode. The speakers will pair together automatically.

3. Pair the speakers with your mobile device for a surround sound experience.

#### POWER BANK FUNCTION

This speaker can charge a mobile phone, plug the USB port of the charging cable into the USB port of the speaker, and connect the other end to the phone to charge the phone.
