


#### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

# HOW TO CHARGE

Fully charge your headset before first use.



Plug in the included USB-C cable to the charging port and connect to a power source.

### CHARGING CASE INDICATOR STATUS

- Power On -
- Pairing Will flash blue & red.
- O Fully Charged Light will turn off.
- Low Battery Continuous flashing.

#### HOW TO WEAR



1. Slide the ear tip into your ear and secure it with the ear hook.

2. Rotate to fit comfortably.

#### POWERING ON/OFF

Power On/Off

Press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds.

NOTE: If there's no connection after 5 minutes, the earbuds will shut off.





Press & Hold for 3 seconds.



#### HOW TO PAIR

Pairing To Your Devices

- 1. Power on the headset. It will automatically enter pairing mode.
- 2. Ensure your phone's Bluetooth settings are
- 3. Select "MyBat Pro Talk2Me" from the list of found devices and pair.







### AUDIO CONTROLS

Play / Pause	Press 1x "MFB"
Volume +	Press 1x "Volume +"
Volume -	Press 1x "Volume -"
Previous Track	Press & Hold "Volume +" (2 Seconds)
Next Track	Press & Hold "Volume -" (2 Seconds)

# CALL CONTROLS

Answer / End Call	Press 1x "MFB"
Reject Call	Press & Hold "MFB" (2 seconds)
Redial Call	Press 2x "MFB"

# RESETTING THE HEADSET

If your headset isn't connecting to your device, try resetting the headset.

- 1. Press and hold the MFB button and the Volume + button simultaneously for six seconds.
  After the pairing record has been deleted, the headset indicator lights will flash red and blue,
- 2. Press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds. The headset will turn on and enter pairing mode.
- 3. Refer to the steps for pairing.
